Preparation Instructions for Bedbug treatments

- ♦ Remove and throw away any trash or items that are not needed.
- ♦ Get rid of any furniture that is not needed and if it is infested, put a note on it or damage the furniture and/or mattresses so someone else won't take it and end up with the bedbugs in their home.
- ♦ Vacuum the entire house using a crack & crevice tool around baseboards. Empty and throw away sweeper bag away outside in a seal trashed bag.
- ♦ Move all furniture and stored items away from walls we will have access to the baseboard along all walls. Bed frames, mattresses, box springs and all upholstered furniture will be treated. Do not place any stored items on the furniture to be treated.
- ♦ Remove all bed sheets, bedcovers, dust ruffles, clothing from dressers and closet, etc. and thoroughly launder these items in HOT water and plenty of soap. Dry at hottest setting in dryer.
- ♦ If you need to make room for items, do NOT put any items that might have bedbugs in them in trash bags, boxes, or storage totes.

After our treatment wait 4 hours before you enter the unit, then open windows and doors to let it air out. **All people and pets must be out of the unit for at least 4 hours after the treatment.**

Be sure to check and confirm that all treated areas are dry before occupying a room or bringing in pets or children.

Continue to keep clutter down and trash taken out regularly.

Do not bring in used furniture unless it is thoroughly inspected and/or treated for bedbugs.

To eliminate bedbug infestations, we will need to make several treatments and these instructions must be followed prior to each treatment. Treatments will be done in 1 to 2 week intervals. On average it takes a series of 4-8 (average 3-5) comprehensive treatments to eliminate bedbug infestation, along with your assurance that you do not bring more bedbugs back into the unit, or allow visitors that have bedbugs to come into your home.
